Announcements for the Sixteenth Sunday after Pentecost: Proper 18

September 4, 2016

HYMN STUDY: #541 - "COME, LABOR ON"

"Based on the Gospels of Jn. 4:35-37 and Mt. 9:37-38, this hymn for church workers by Jane Laurie Borthwick was first published in *Thoughts for Thoughtful Hours* (London, 1859). The seven six-lined stanzas were transformed into seven five-line stanzas in a later edition of 1863." (*The Hymnal 1982 Companion*, Vol. 3B, p. 1007-8).

Note: Stanza 4 was originally stanza 2, while stanzas 3 and 7 of the 1863 version are omitted in the 1982 Hymnal. Here is the 1863 version in its entirety:

"Labour For Christ" by Jane Laurie Borthwick

Come, labour on!
Who dares stand idle on the harvest plain?
While all around him waves the golden grain,
And to each servant does the Master say,
"Go work today."

Come, labour on!
Claim the high calling angels cannot share, ~
To young and old the Gospel gladness bear;
Redeem the time, its hours too swiftly fly,
The night draws nigh.

Come, labour on!
The labourers are few, the field is wide,
New stations must be filled, and blanks supplied;
From voices distant far, or near at home,
The call is, "Come."

Come, labour on!
The enemy is watching night and day,
To sow the tares, to snatch the seed away.
While we in sleep our duty have forgot,
He slumbered not.

Come, labour on!
Away with gloomy doubts and faithless fear!
No arm so weak but may do service here;
By feeblest agents may our God fulfill
His righteous will.

Come, labour on!
No time for rest, till glows the western sky,
While the long shadows o'er our pathway lie,
And a glad sound comes with the setting sun, ~
"Servants, well done!"

Come, labour on!
The toil is pleasant, the reward is sure,
Blessed are those who to the end endure; ~
How full their joy, how deep their rest shall be,
O Lord, with thee.
